"Whoever teaches me a letter, I become his servant." — Imam Ali ibn Abi Talib

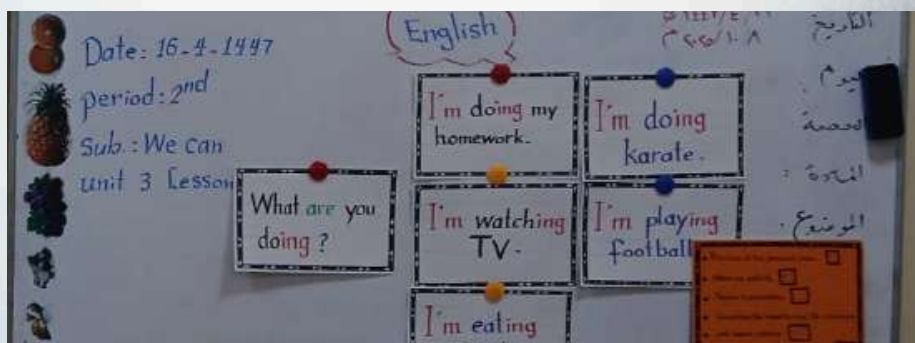
